it takes three people to position me... to be honest, it's a bit degrading • just the thought of getting THAT [mammogram] done and being uncomfortable... I don't feel like a part of my recovery • they thought they were accommodating me... but it felt inappropriate and unsafe • I'm at the point where I'm so tired of being turned away • I don't know if they're intimidated by my disability... it feels like they don't even want to touch me
